She was only 13 years old when she joined les Ballets Africains, THE national Guinea's ballet, and became soloist dancer in several creations (Wassara, Soundjata, Forêt Sacrée, Mali Sayo). Thanks to her talent, she crossed borders and conquered many bands which wanted to enrole her : Les Amazones and the Bembeya Jazz Orchestra, Fatala et Africa Soli in Netherlands, Mamady Keita's band Sewa Kan, ... In 1997 she's named as cultural ambassador in Sweden by NOKA International. As she has an excellent pedagogy and a overflowing energy, she teaches traditional dances from several guinean etnies all over the world (Europe, Asia, Africa). To her pupils, she gives the love of her culture and shares her knowledge of guinean dances and traditions like nobody else !

This journey is based on **CULTURAL EXCHANGE**. The guinea culture is so rich and now the guinea youth is here to share with you ! Guinea as so much to give !!!

Trainees will discover **CONAKRY** the capital, but also Bel Air beaches, on **AFRICA FARE** camp at **DAN KELÉ KELÉ** (at seaside, on one of the most beautiful beach of Guinea - near Boffa).

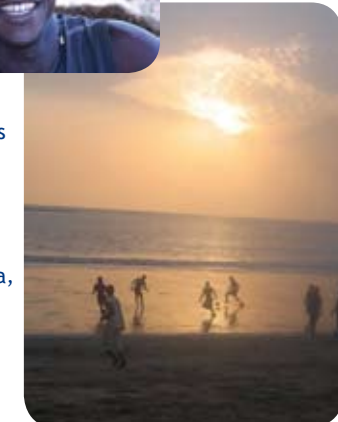
Not only dancing and singing will be taught to the trainees, but also playing several traditional percussion's instruments.

We propose to djembe players (with a good level, 4th year of practice), to register to the workshop to be taught to play for the dance lessons, during all the workshop. the band performs at the end of each week, in a way to pay tribute to the inhabitants, and share with them the dances and songs that have been learned.

In Dan Kele Kele, the trainees will sleep in Africa Fare's camp, in traditional houses of 4 or 5 people each.

In Conakry, the band will stay in its own house.

Meals : Alternated traditional african and european cooking, made by our chief.



TRIP - JOURNEY

- A passport with a visa is a must.
- **IMPORTANT** : Get the international vaccinations required ! A preliminary medical visit is necessary to check all the vaccinations and medicins required (paludism, anti-mosquitos, diarrhea, ...).
- At this time of the year, the temperature is about 30°C. But also take some warm clothes for Bel Air, nights nights are fresh at the seaside !

You'll work with exceptional musicians from prestigious ballets : Ousmane Soumah, as known as Tozo, Pascal and Mohamed Camara, as known as Akebou.
